Town	A small place where people live.
City	A place people live that is larger than a town. Every city is in a country.
Country	A land that is run by a government.
Continent	A group of countries. There are 7 continents on Earth.
Ocean	A large area of water or sea. There are 5 main oceans.
Globe	A round model of the world
Map	A detailed plan of an area
Equator	Divides earth into 2 equal parts: the northern and the southern hemispheres.
Poles	There are 2 poles, North Pole and South Pole.
Seasons	These are the 4 different times during the year with different types of weather: Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.
Weather	The conditions outside, like the rain or the sun
Direction	There are 4 directions on a compass: North, South, East and West. Directions tell us where to go or where to find something.

Key Facts

- There are 7 continents: Antarctica, Asia, Australia, Africa, North America, South America, Europe.
- There are 5 oceans: Atlantic, Pacific, Indian, Southern, Arctic.
- The United Kingdom is made up of 4 countries. They are England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.
- Bristol is a city in England, United Kingdom.
- India is a country in Asia
- The directions on a compass are North East, South and West.
- Human features in Easton, Bristol are: City, Shop, Bus, House
- Physical features in the local area: Hill, River, Rain, Oak tree
- Human features in India : Village, Rickshaw, Sari, Turban, Cricket
- Physical features in India—Mountain River Monsoon Palm tree
- I can name the seasons: Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter
- In the Spring it is warm and wet.
- In the Summer it is hot and dry.
- In the Autumn it is cold, wet and windy.
- In the Winter it is very cold, wet, windy and sometimes snowy
